- Vacuum your refrigerator coils
- Remove, or cover your window air conditioners
- Have your chimney and flues inspected
- Install storm windows if needed
- Turn off your outdoor water supply and remove hoses
- Inspect for roof damage and repair if needed
- Clean your gutters
- Inspect the caulk around your windows and doors re-caulk as needed
- Cover or store your outdoor furniture

WARM PUMPKIN SPICE DRINK (FROM FIVEHEARTHOME.COM)



- 1 cup whole milk, heated until very warm
- ¼ cup canned pumpkin puree
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- ½ teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- Whipped cream and cinnamon

Place all ingredients in blender. Remove center cap from the lid of the blender and use a folded kitchen towel to loosely hold the cap over the hole in a manner that steam can escape. Turn on the blender to low and then increase it to high. Blend ingredients until frothy. Transfer mixture to a mug, top with whipped cream, if desired, and sprinkle with additional pumpkin pie spice or cinnamon.
